THE DIFFERENCE WITH TRADITIONAL **OBSERVATION METHODS**

Traditional lesson observation is usually planned well in advance and involves the observer standing at the back of the classroom or in the optimum spot that allows them to have a view of the teacher teaching.

This means that the teacher does not know what the observer is thinking in real-time and that can cause the lesson to take on a very different feel than if the observer effect was removed. Students pick up on this effect and that can impact negatively on their learning.

This form of classroom observation can lead to misleading or biased results: both the teacher and the students know they are being observed, leading to unnatural behaviour. Some lesson observations are captured using temporary portable devices, which can also be intrusive and distracting to the lesson being delivered.
